# American Roulette



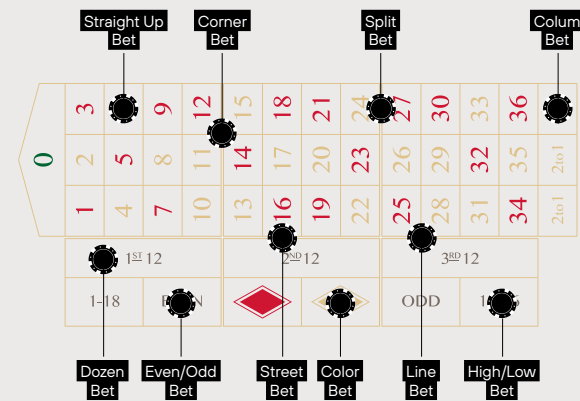
Roulette uses a spinning wheel with 37 individually numbered pockets. Each wheel has a series of obstacles that causes the ball to bounce around with each spin and land on an arbitrary number.

The players can bet with coloured chips, which are purchased at the table and have a certain value, or with cash chips, which have a higher value than the table minimum.

The players can bet on the number as well as place outside bets and racetrack bets. The bets are paid out depending on the odds. The racetrack is an exact copy of the sequence of the numbers on the wheel, which is also divided into sections: Big series, small series, orphelins and zero game.

## Odds

Odds	Payout rate	Tally of played numbers
<b>Simple wagers</b>	1:1	18
<b>Dozens, columns</b>	2:1	12
<b>Six line</b>	5:1	6
<b>Corner</b>	8:1	4
<b>Street</b>	11:1	3
<b>Split</b>	17:1	2
<b>Straight-up</b>	35:1	1



## Game variations

### The small series, or series 5/8

This refers to the sector on the wheel that includes the following bets:  
5/8, 10/11 13/16, 23/24, 27/30, 33/36 (all splits)  
Six units are needed for this game.

### The big series, or series 0/2/3

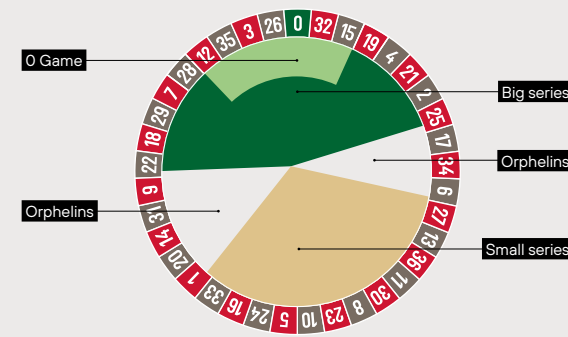
This refers to the sector on the wheel that includes the following bets:  
0/2/3 (street), 4/7, 12/15, 18/21, 19/22 (split), 25/26/28/29 (corner), 32/35  
Nine units are needed for this game.

### Orphelins / orphans

This refers to two separate sectors on the wheel that include the following bets:  
1 (straight up), 6/9, 14/17, 17/20, 31/34 (split)  
Five units are needed for this game.

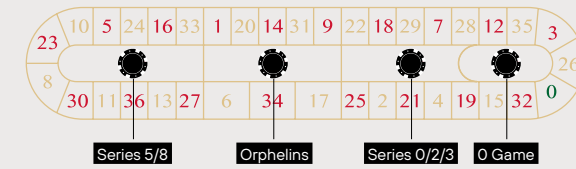
### Zero game

This refers to the sector on the wheel that includes the following bet placements:  
0/3, 12/15, 26 (straight up), 32/35  
Four units are needed for this game.



## Racetrack

In addition to a specific centre number, one or more neighbouring numbers on either side are played. For example: 17 and a neighbour to the left and right = three chips (one chip each on 17, 25, 34), 17 and two neighbours to the left and right = five chips (on chip each on 2, 25, 17, 34, 6), 17 and three neighbours to the left and right = seven chips



## Finals

Finals mean all numbers with the same last digit.

## Minimum – maximum

Minimum/maximum bets are prescribed values and are always posted on the table. In the event of disputes, the final decision is made by management.
